AN ACT concerning motor vehicle registrations; relating to proof of
 financial security; amending K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 8-173 and repealing
 the existing section.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 8-173 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 8-173. (a) An application for registration of a vehicle as provided 8 in article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and 9 amendments thereto, shall not be accepted unless the person making such 10 application shall exhibit:

(1) A receipt showing that such person has paid all personal property
 taxes levied against such person for the preceding year, including taxes
 upon such vehicle, except that if such application is made before May 11,
 such receipt need show payment of only one-half the preceding year's tax;
 or

(2) evidence that such vehicle was assessed for taxation purposes by
a state agency, or was assessed as stock in trade of a merchant or
manufacturer or was exempt from taxation under the laws of this state.

(b) An application for registration of a vehicle as provided in article
1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated shall not be accepted if
the records of the county treasurer show that the applicant is delinquent
and owes personal property taxes levied against the applicant for any
preceding year.

(c) An *original* application for registration or renewal of registration of a motor vehicle shall not be accepted until the applicant signs a certification, provided by the director of motor vehicles, certifying that the applicant has and will maintain, during the period of registration, the required insurance, self-insurance or other financial security required pursuant to K.S.A. 40-3104, and amendments thereto.

(d) An application for registration or renewal of registration of a
vehicle shall not be accepted if the applicant is unable to provide proof of
the insurance, self-insurance or other financial security required by article
31 of chapter 40 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated. Proof of insurance
shall be verified by examination of the insurance card or other
documentation issued by an insurance company, a certificate of selfinsurance issued by the commissioner, a binder of insurance, a certificate

of insurance, a motor carrier identification number issued by the state 1 corporation commission, proof of insurance for vehicles covered under a 2 fleet policy, a commercial policy covering more than one vehicle or a 3 policy of insurance required by K.S.A. 40-3104, and amendments thereto, 4 and for vehicles used as part of a drivers education program, a dealership 5 contract and a copy of a motor vehicle liability insurance policy issued to 6 7 a school district or accredited nonpublic school. Examination of a 8 photocopy or facsimile of any of these documents shall suffice for verification of registration or renewal. Proof of insurance may also be 9 verified on-line or electronically and the commissioner of insurance may 10 require, by duly adopted rules and regulations, any motor vehicle liability 11 insurance company authorized to do business in this state to provide 12 verification of insurance in that manner. Any motor vehicle liability 13 insurance company which is providing verification of insurance on-line 14 or electronically on the day preceding the effective date of this act may 15 continue to do so in the same manner and shall be deemed to be in 16 17 compliance with this section.
