1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas highway patrol; allowing the
2 Superintendent to charge and collect fees for certain services.
3

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) The superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol is
6 hereby authorized to ~~fix~~, **negotiate and enter into contracts, and**
7 charge and collect fees for providing security and traffic patrol services
8 at events held by private entities where the superintendent determines
9 the number of people attending such event will have a significant
10 impact on traffic and law enforcement activities on state highways.
11 Such fees shall be fixed in order to recover ~~all or part of~~ the expenses
12 incurred in providing such services by the Kansas highway patrol. **The**
13 **Kansas highway patrol shall determine the amount of traffic patrol**
14 **services and security necessary at events held by private entities**
15 **and shall set fees accordingly.** This section shall not apply to any
16 event organized or operated by the state of Kansas or a city, county or
17 other political subdivision thereof. ~~All moneys received by the~~
18 ~~superintendent for such services shall be deposited in the state treasury~~
19 ~~in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments~~
20 ~~thereto, and shall be credited to the Kansas highway patrol operations~~
21 ~~fund.~~

22 (b) The Kansas highway patrol shall only fix, charge and
23 collect fees pursuant to this section when, in the opinion of the
24 superintendent, the expenses incurred to the highway patrol for
25 providing such security and traffic patrol services will exceed
26 \$20,000.

27 (c) There is hereby created the highway patrol private security
28 fund. All moneys deposited into the highway patrol private security
29 fund shall be used only for the purpose of providing for security to
30 private entities pursuant to this section. All expenditures from the
31 highway patrol private security fund shall be made in accordance
32 with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts
33 and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the

1 **superintendent or the designee of the superintendent. All moneys**
2 **received by the superintendent for such services shall be deposited**
3 **in the state treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-**
4 **4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the**
5 **highway patrol private security fund.**

6 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
7 publication in the statute book.
