AN ACT providing for the phasing out and closure of the school for the deaf and the school for the blind.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) On and after the effective date of the act, the state board of education shall commence planning for and provide for the phase-out and ultimate closing of the Kansas state school for the deaf and the Kansas state school for the blind.

- (b) The board shall report on or before January 9, 2012, to the governor, the committee on education of the senate, the committee on education of the house of representatives, the committee on ways and means of the senate and the committee on appropriations of the house of representatives any recommendations the board may have concerning the phase-out and closing of the Kansas state school for the deaf and the Kansas state school for the blind. The report and recommendations shall include, but not be limited to, the following: Options for alternative placement of the students served by the two schools; recommendations with regard to severance benefits for the staff and teachers of the two schools; recommendations for the disposal of personal and real property of the two schools; recommendations concerning legislation which might be needed to carry out the closure of the two schools; and other matters as the board deems appropriate.
- (c) The Kansas state school for the deaf and the Kansas state school for the blind shall be closed by the board and cease to exist as state institutions on July 1, 2012.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
