1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years
2 ending June 30, 2011, and June 30, 2012, for the department of
3 education; authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects
4 and fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or
5 authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the
6 foregoing.

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8 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

9 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2011, and June 30,
10 2012, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are
11 hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees,
12 receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby
13 directed or authorized as provided in this act.

15 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

16 (a) (1) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, on or before April
17 15, 2011, the commissioner of education, the director of legislative
18 research and the director of the budget shall jointly determine the amount
19 of moneys that are required to satisfy the maintenance of state financial
20 support provisions of the federal individuals with disabilities education
21 act, as amended, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, based on recent
22 estimates and other available information pertaining thereto, and shall
23 jointly certify the amount so determined to the director of accounts and
24 reports.

25 (2) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, upon receipt of such
26 joint certification pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the director of accounts
27 and reports shall transfer the amount prescribed in such certification from
28 the KPERS – employer contributions account of the state general fund to
29 the special education services aid account of the state general fund.

30 (3) On or after July 1, 2011, or as soon thereafter as moneys are
31 available therefor, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer the
32 amount prescribed in such joint certification, pursuant to subsection (a)
33 (1), from the general state aid account of the state general fund to the
34 KPERS – employer contributions account of the state general fund.

35 (4) At the same time that such joint certification is transmitted to the

1 director of accounts and reports pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the
2 commissioner of education, the director of legislative research and the
3 director of the budget shall jointly transmit a copy of such certification to
4 the speaker of the house of representatives, the speaker pro tem of the
5 house of representatives, the majority leader of the house of
6 representatives, the minority leader of the house of representatives, the
7 chairperson of the committee on appropriations of the house of
8 representatives, the chief clerk of the house of representatives, the
9 president of the senate, the vice-president of the senate, the majority
10 leader of the senate, the minority leader of the senate, the chairperson of
11 the committee on ways and means of the senate and the secretary of the
12 senate.

13 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
14 publication in the Kansas register.

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
