Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

8 K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-8963 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-8963. (a) For the purpose of financing a capital 9 10 improvement project of the Kansas bioscience authority relating to a national bio and agro defense facility, the Kansas development finance 11 12 authority is hereby authorized to issue one or more series of revenue bonds 13 pursuant to the Kansas development finance authority act, K.S.A. 74-8901 14 et seq., and amendments thereto, in an amount necessary to provide a 15 deposit or deposits to the bioscience development and investment fund, 16 established by K.S.A. 74-99b34, and amendments thereto which is hereby 17 created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the department 18 of administration in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 19 74-8963 through 74-8967, and amendments thereto, in a total amount not 20 to exceed \$105,000,000, plus all amounts required for costs of bond 21 issuance, costs of interest on the bonds issued for such capital 22 improvement project during the construction of such project, cost of bond 23 insurance or other credit enhancement for the bonds and any required 24 reserves for the payment of principal and interest on the bonds, for a 25 capital improvement project relating to a national bio and agro defense facility, including, but not limited to, land acquisition, site preparation, 26 27 fencing, central utility plant facility construction and improvements, 28 including electric, water and sewer utility infrastructure construction and 29 equipment, lift stations, street grading, paving, graveling, macadamizing, 30 curbing, guttering and surfacing, street light fixture connections and 31 facilities, underground gas, water, heating and electrical services and 32 connections, sidewalks and parking facilities, drives and driveway 33 approaches, landscaping and plantings and related facilities and amenities 34 to develop and finance the project. 35

(b) On and after the effective date of this act, prior to the issuance of any bonds pursuant to this section, the capital improvement project

described in subsection (a) shall be approved for the Kansas bioseience authority department of administration for the purposes of subsection (e) (b) of K.S.A. 74-8905, and amendments thereto, and for the purposes of K.S.A. 74-99b10, and amendments thereto, and the authorization of the issuance of bonds by the Kansas development finance authority shall be approved by the Kansas development finance authority in accordance with K.S.A. 74-8901 et seq., and amendments thereto.

- (c) The Kansas bioseience authority department of administration may only make expenditures from the moneys received from the issuance of any bonds pursuant to this section for those purposes set forth in subsection (a) for the capital improvement project.
- (d) The debt service for any such bonds issued pursuant to this section shall be financed by appropriations from the state general fund or any appropriate special revenue fund or funds.
- (e) The date of maturity on bonds issued pursuant to this section shall not be fixed for a period of time which exceeds 20 years from the date of issuance.
- (f) The proceeds from the sale of any bonds, other than refunding bonds, issued pursuant to this section, after payment of any costs related to the issuance of such bonds, shall be paid by the Kansas development finance authority to the Kansas bioscience authoritydepartment of administration to be applied to the payment of the costs of the capital improvement project authorized by resolution of the Kansas bioscience authoritypursuant to this section as requested by the secretary of administration and by resolution of the Kansas development finance authority.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 74-8963 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
