1 AN ACT regulating traffic; restricting the use of wireless telephones while 2 operating school buses. 3 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 5 (a) The use of a wireless telephone by an operator of a Section 1. 6 school bus on a public road or highway shall be unlawful except when the 7 telephone is a hands-free wireless telephone. 8 (b) The operator of a school bus may use a hand-held wireless 9 telephone while driving with one hand on the steering wheel only if: (1) Communicating with a central dispatch, school transportation 10 department or its equivalent; or 11 12 (2) the operator is using the telephone to report to appropriate authorities a fire, a traffic accident, a serious road hazard or medical or 13 14 other hazardous materials emergency, or to report the operator of another 15 motor vehicle who is driving in a reckless, careless or otherwise unsafe 16 manner or who appears to be driving under the influence of alcohol or 17 drugs. A hand-held wireless telephone user's records or the testimony or 18 written statements from appropriate authorities receiving such calls shall 19 be deemed sufficient evidence of the existence of all lawful calls made 20 under this paragraph. 21 (c) An initial violation under this section by an operator shall result in 22 a fine of \$50 including no court costs. Subsequent violations by an 23 operator shall result in a fine of \$100 including no court costs. 24 (d) No court shall report violation of this section to the department of 25 revenue. 26 (e) As used in this section: 27 (1) "School bus" has the same meaning as that term is defined in 28 K.S.A. 8-1461, and amendments thereto; 29 "hands-free wireless telephone" means a mobile telephone that (2)has an internal feature or function, or that is equipped with an attachment 30 31 or addition, whether or not permanently part of such mobile telephone, by 32 which a user engages in a conversation without the use of either hand to 33 activate, deactivate or initiate a function of the telephone; 34 (3) "use of a wireless telephone" shall include, but not be limited to, 35 talking or listening to another person on the telephone. (f) This act shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act 36
