

**HOUSE BILL No. 2502**

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1 AN ACT concerning agriculture; relating to swine production facilities and  
2 establishment procedures; amending K.S.A. 17-5907 and 17-5908 and  
3 repealing the existing sections.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 17-5907 is hereby amended to read as follows: 17-  
7 5907. (a) (1) The board of county commissioners, by resolution, may  
8 permit **or deny** a dairy production facility, as defined in K.S.A. 17-5903,  
9 and amendments thereto, to be established within the county. Such  
10 resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in  
11 the official county newspaper. The resolution shall take effect 60 days after  
12 final publication unless a valid petition in opposition to the same is filed.

13 (2) If within 60 days of the final publication of the resolution, a valid  
14 protest petition to submit the resolution to the qualified voters of the  
15 county is signed by qualified electors of the county equal in number to not  
16 less than ~~5% 10%~~ **5%** of the electors of the county who voted for the  
17 office of secretary of state at the last preceding general election at which  
18 such office was elected and is filed with the county election officer, the  
19 county election officer shall submit the question, as established in  
20 subsection (c), of whether a dairy production facility shall be allowed to be  
21 established in such county at the next ~~countywide~~ **state, county or special**  
22 election.

23 (b) (1) The board of county commissioners, upon a petition filed in  
24 accordance with paragraph (b)(2), shall submit to the qualified electors of  
25 the county a proposition to permit a dairy production facility, as defined in  
26 K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments thereto, to be established within the  
27 county.

28 (2) A petition to submit a proposition to the qualified voters of a  
29 county pursuant to this section shall be filed with the county election  
30 officer. The petition shall be signed by qualified electors of the county  
31 equal in number to not less than ~~5% 10%~~ **5%** of the electors of the county  
32 who voted for the office of secretary of state at the last preceding general  
33 election at which such office was elected. The following shall appear on  
34 the petition:

1 "We request an election to determine whether a ~~corporation, trust,~~  
2 ~~limited liability company, limited partnership or corporate partnership,~~  
3 ~~other than a family farm corporation, authorized farm corporation, limited~~  
4 ~~liability agricultural company, limited agricultural partnership, family~~  
5 ~~trust, authorized trust or testamentary trust~~ **business entity authorized and**  
6 **regulated under Kansas law to form a dairy production facility** shall be  
7 allowed to, ~~either directly or indirectly,~~ own, acquire or otherwise obtain or  
8 lease any agricultural land in \_\_\_\_\_ county for the purpose of  
9 establishing a dairy production facility."

10 (3) Upon the submission of a valid petition calling for an election  
11 pursuant to this subsection, the county election officer shall submit the  
12 question, as established in subsection (c), of whether a dairy production  
13 facility shall be allowed to be established in such county at the next  
14 countywide election which occurs more than 60 days after the petition is  
15 filed with the county election officer.

16 (c) In any election established pursuant to this section, the following  
17 shall appear on the ballot:

18 "Shall a ~~corporation, trust, limited liability company, limited~~  
19 ~~partnership or corporate partnership, other than a family farm corporation,~~  
20 ~~authorized farm corporation, limited liability agricultural company, limited~~  
21 ~~agricultural partnership, family trust, authorized trust or testamentary trust~~  
22 **business entity authorized and regulated under Kansas law to form a**  
23 **dairy production facility** be allowed to, ~~either directly or indirectly,~~ own,  
24 acquire or otherwise obtain or lease any agricultural land in \_\_\_\_\_  
25 county for the purpose of establishing a dairy production facility? **Such**  
26 **facility shall be in compliance with rules and regulations of the Kansas**  
27 **department of health and environment, the Kansas department of**  
28 **agriculture and any other state agency."**

29 (d) If a majority of the votes cast and counted are in opposition to  
30 allowing dairy production facilities to be established in such county, the  
31 county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result to the secretary of  
32 state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result of such election  
33 and that dairy production facilities are not allowed to be established in  
34 such county.

35 (e) If a majority of the votes cast and counted is in favor of the  
36 proposition, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result  
37 to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result  
38 of such election and that dairy production facilities are allowed to be  
39 established in such county.

40 (f) The election provided for by this section shall be conducted, and  
41 the votes counted and canvassed, in the manner provided by law for  
42 question submitted elections of the county.

43 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 17-5908 is hereby amended to read as follows: 17-

1 5908. (a) ~~The board of county commissioners, by resolution, may submit~~  
2 ~~to the qualified voters of the county a proposition to allow swine~~  
3 ~~production facilities, as defined in K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments~~  
4 ~~thereto, to be established within the county. Upon adoption of such~~  
5 ~~resolution, the county election officer shall submit the question of whether~~  
6 ~~swine production facilities shall be allowed to be established in such~~  
7 ~~county at the next state or county-wide regular or special election.~~

8 (b) (1) ~~The board of county commissioners, upon a petition filed in~~  
9 ~~accordance with paragraph (b)(2), shall submit to the qualified voters of~~  
10 ~~the county a proposition to allow swine production facilities, as defined in~~  
11 ~~K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments thereto, to be established within the~~  
12 ~~county.~~

13 (2) ~~A petition to submit a proposition to the qualified voters of a~~  
14 ~~county pursuant to this subsection (b) shall be filed with the county~~  
15 ~~election officer. The petition shall be signed by qualified voters of the~~  
16 ~~county equal in number to not less than 5% of the voters of the county who~~  
17 ~~voted for the office of secretary of state at the last preceding general~~  
18 ~~election at which such office was elected. The following shall appear on~~  
19 ~~the petition:~~

20 ~~"We request an election to determine whether corporate swine~~  
21 ~~production facilities shall be allowed to be established in \_\_\_\_\_ county,~~  
22 ~~pursuant to K.S.A. 17-5904."~~

23 (3) ~~Upon the submission of a valid petition calling for an election~~  
24 ~~pursuant to this subsection, the county election officer shall submit the~~  
25 ~~question of whether swine production facilities shall be allowed to be~~  
26 ~~established in such county at the next state or county-wide regular or~~  
27 ~~special election which occurs more than 60 days after the petition is filed~~  
28 ~~with the county election officer.~~

29 (c) ~~If a majority of the votes cast and counted are in opposition to~~  
30 ~~allowing swine production facilities to be established in such county, the~~  
31 ~~county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result to the secretary of~~  
32 ~~state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result of such election~~  
33 ~~and that swine production facilities are not allowed to be established in~~  
34 ~~such county.~~

35 (d) ~~If a majority of the votes cast and counted is in favor of the~~  
36 ~~proposition, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result~~  
37 ~~to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result~~  
38 ~~of such election and that swine production facilities are allowed to be~~  
39 ~~established in such county.~~

40 (e) ~~The election provided for by this section shall be conducted, and~~  
41 ~~the votes counted and canvassed, in the manner provided by law for~~  
42 ~~question submitted elections of the county, except that the county election~~  
43 ~~officer shall publish in the official county newspaper a notice of such~~

1 election once each week for two consecutive weeks, the first publication to  
2 be not less than 21 days before the election, and such notice shall state the  
3 date and time of the election and the proposition that will appear on the  
4 ballot. (a) (1) The board of county commissioners, by resolution, may  
5 permit or deny a swine production facility, as defined in K.S.A. 17-5903,  
6 and amendments thereto, to be established within the county. Such  
7 resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in  
8 the official county newspaper. The resolution shall take effect 60 days after  
9 final publication unless a valid petition in opposition to the same is filed.

10 (2) If within 60 days of the final publication of the resolution, a valid  
11 protest petition to submit the resolution to the qualified voters of the  
12 county is signed by qualified electors of the county equal in number to not  
13 less than ~~10%~~ 5% of the electors of the county who voted for the office of  
14 secretary of state at the last preceding general election at which such  
15 office was elected and is filed with the county election officer, the county  
16 election officer shall submit the question, as established in subsection (c),  
17 of whether a swine production facility shall be allowed to be established in  
18 such county at the next ~~countywide~~ **state, county or special** election.

19 (b) (1) The board of county commissioners, upon a petition filed in  
20 accordance with paragraph (b)(2), shall submit to the qualified electors of  
21 the county a proposition to permit a swine production facility, as defined  
22 in K.S.A. 17-5903, and amendments thereto, to be established within the  
23 county.

24 (2) A petition to submit a proposition to the qualified voters of a  
25 county pursuant to this section shall be filed with the county election

27 equal in number to not less than ~~10%~~ 5% of the electors of the county who  
28 voted for the office of secretary of state at the last preceding general  
29 election at which such office was elected. The following shall appear on  
30 the petition:

33 ~~other than a family farm corporation, authorized farm corporation,~~

35 ~~family trust, authorized trust or testamentary trust~~ **business entity**  
36 **authorized and regulated under Kansas law to form a swine production**  
37 **facility shall be allowed to, either directly or indirectly, own, acquire or**  
38 **otherwise obtain or lease any agricultural land in \_\_\_\_\_ county for**  
39 **the purpose of establishing a swine production facility."**

40 (3) Upon the submission of a valid petition calling for an election  
41 pursuant to this subsection, the county election officer shall submit the  
42 question, as established in subsection (c), of whether a swine production  
43 facility shall be allowed to be established in such county at the next

1 countywide election which occurs more than 60 days after the petition is  
2 filed with the county election officer.

3 (c) In any election established pursuant to this section, the following  
4 shall appear on the ballot:

5 ~~"Shall a corporation, trust, limited liability company, limited~~  
6 ~~partnership or corporate partnership, other than a family farm~~  
7 ~~corporation, authorized farm corporation, limited liability agricultural~~  
8 ~~company, limited agricultural partnership, family trust, authorized trust or~~  
9 ~~testamentary trust business entity authorized and regulated under~~  
10 **Kansas law to form a swine production facility be allowed to, either**  
11 **directly or indirectly, own, acquire or otherwise obtain or lease any**  
12 **agricultural land in \_\_\_\_\_ county for the purpose of establishing a**  
13 **swine production facility? Such facility shall be in compliance with**  
14 **rules and regulations of the Kansas department of health and**  
15 **environment, the Kansas department of agriculture and any other**  
16 **state agency."**

17 (d) If a majority of the votes cast and counted are in opposition to  
18 allowing swine production facilities to be established in such county, the  
19 county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result to the secretary  
20 of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result of such election  
21 and that swine production facilities are not allowed to be established in  
22 such county.

23 (e) If a majority of the votes cast and counted is in favor of the  
24 proposition, the county election officer shall transmit a copy of the result  
25 to the secretary of state who shall publish in the Kansas register the result  
26 of such election and that swine production facilities are allowed to be  
27 established in such county.

28 (f) The election provided for by this section shall be conducted, and  
29 the votes counted and canvassed, in the manner provided by law for  
30 question submitted elections of the county.

31 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 17-5907 and 17-5908 are hereby repealed.

32 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
33 publication in the statute book.

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
