AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relating to the Kansas alien rapid repatriation act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) This act shall be known and may be cited as the Kansas criminal alien rapid repatriation act.
- (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the secretary of corrections may conditionally release any prisoner in the secretary's custody to the custody and control of the United States immigration and customs enforcement, provided the secretary has received an order of deportation for such prisoner and such prisoner:
- (1) Has served at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of the prison portion of the sentence imposed by the court; and
- (2) is not serving a sentence imposed for a conviction of a person felony.
- (c) If a prisoner released pursuant to this section returns illegally to the United States, upon notice of such prisoner's incarceration from any federal or state law enforcement agency, the secretary shall revoke the conditional release of such prisoner and such prisoner shall serve the remainder of the sentence imposed by the court. Such prisoner shall not be eligible for probation or conditional release, as provided in this section, on any sentence affected by such release.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
