AN ACT concerning the state capitol building; requiring the establishment of an all faiths chapel.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The legislature declares that:

- (1) Belief in God, prayer and meditation have played a significant part of the history and culture of the United States since its founding;
- (2) belief in God, prayer and meditation have played a significant role in the history and culture of the state of Kansas since its founding;
- (3) the historical importance of the right to worship God according to the dictates of one's conscience and of prayer and meditation is reflected in section 7 of the bill of rights of the constitution of the state of Kansas and in the practice of beginning each daily session in the Kansas house of representatives and senate with a prayer; and
- (4) Kansas has a history of setting aside space in the state capitol for a place of prayer and meditation.
- (b) The legislative coordinating council shall reestablish an all faiths chapel as a place reserved for prayer and meditation in the state capitol building.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
