1 AN ACT concerning the secretary of state; relating to ballot language 2 statements.

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4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) A county election officer may request the preparation 6 of a ballot language statement for the purposes of explaining the language 7 of a ballot question of any municipality as defined by K.S.A. 75-6102, and 8 amendments thereto.

9 (1) If the ballot question language was derived from a petition 10 submitted to the office of the county attorney, district attorney or county 11 counselor pursuant to K.S.A. 25-3601, and amendments thereto, such 12 county election officer shall request the office of the county attorney, 13 district attorney or county attorney, as applicable, to prepare the ballot 14 language statement in compliance with the requirements of subsection (a) 15 (3).

16 (2) If the ballot language statement did not derive from a petition 17 submitted to the office of the county attorney, district attorney or county 18 counselor pursuant to K.S.A. 25-3601, and amendments thereto, such 19 county election officer shall request the office of secretary of state to 20 prepare the ballot language statement in compliance with the requirements 21 of subsection (a)(3).

(3) A ballot language statement shall fairly and accurately explain what a vote for and what a vote against the measure represents. Such ballot language statements shall be true and impartial statements of the effect of a vote for and against the measure in language neither intentionally argumentative nor likely to create prejudice for or against the proposed measure. A ballot language statement shall be prepared and transmitted in good faith and without malice.

29 (b) (1) Within 15 days of a request by a county election officer to 30 prepare a ballot language statement pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the 31 office of the county attorney, district attorney or county counselor, as 32 applicable, shall prepare and forward such ballot language statement to the 33 office of secretary of state for approval by the secretary of state or the 34 secretary of state's designee that such ballot language statement complies 35 with the requirements of subsection (a)(3). Within five days following 36 receipt of the ballot language statement, the office of secretary of state

1 shall furnish the county election officer the ballot language statement as 2 approved by the office of secretary of state as in compliance with the 3 requirements of subsection (a)(3).

4 (b) (2) The secretary of state or the secretary's designee shall prepare 5 a ballot language statement within 20 days of a request by a county 6 election officer to prepare a ballot language statement pursuant to 7 subsection (a)(2).

8 (c) A ballot language statement prepared under this section shall be 9 posted in each polling place and made available for public inspection in 10 the office of the county election officer. A ballot language statement 11 prepared under this section may be posted on the official website of the 12 county.

13 There shall be no cause of action at law or in equity challenging (d) 14 the validity of the form of a ballot language statement prepared under this section. There shall be no liability on the part of and no cause of action of 15 16 any nature shall arise against the secretary of state, the secretary of state's 17 employees, the county election officer, the county attorney, the district 18 attorney or the county counselor as a result of the preparation of a ballot 19 language statement under this section. The preparation of a ballot 20 language statement shall not form any basis for an election contest or 21 result in the waiver of any immunity by the state or any of its subdivisions.

22 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 23 publication in the Kansas Register.
