AN ACT concerning the Kansas credit services organization act; relating 1 2 to the exemptions therefrom; amending K.S.A. 50-1116 and 50-1117 3 and repealing the existing sections. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 50-1116 is hereby amended to read as follows: 50-6 7 1116. (a) K.S.A. 50-1116 through 50-1135, and amendments thereto, shall 8 be known and may be cited as the Kansas credit services organization act. 9 (b) Any person individual licensed to practice law in this state acting within the course and scope of such person's individual's practice as an 10 11 attorney, and such person's individual's law firm, shall be exempt from the 12 provisions of this act. 13 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 50-1117 is hereby amended to read as follows: 50-14 1117. Definitions as used in this act: (a) "Commissioner" means the state 15 bank commissioner. (b) "Consumer" means an individual who is a resident of this state. 16 17 "Credit services organization" means a person who engages in, or (c) holds out to the public as willing to engage in, the business of debt 18 19 management services for a fee, compensation or gain, or in the expectation 20 of a fee, compensation or gain. (d) "Debt management service" means: 21 22 (1) Receiving or offering to receive funds from a consumer for the 23 purpose of distributing the funds among such consumer's creditors in full 24 or partial payment of such consumer's debts; 25 (2) improving or offering to improve a consumer's credit record, 26 history or rating; or 27 (3) negotiating or offering to negotiate to defer or reduce a 28 consumer's obligations with respect to credit extended by others. 29 "Insolvent" means a person whose debts exceed their assets. (e) "Law firm" means a lawyer or lawyers in a law partnership, 30 (f) professional corporation, sole proprietorship or other association 31 authorized to practice law; or lawyers employed in a legal services 32 organization or the legal department of a corporation or other 33 34 organization. 35 "Person" means any individual, corporation, partnership, (g)association, unincorporated organization or other form of entity, however 36

1 organized, including a nonprofit entity.

(g) (h) "Related interest" means a person:
(1) With respect to an individual who is:

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(A) The spouse of the individual;

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(B) a brother, brother-in-law, sister, sister-in-law of the individual;

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6 (C) an ancestor or lineal descendant of the individual or the 7 individual's spouse; and

8 (D) any other relative, by blood, adoption or marriage, of the 9 individual or such individual's spouse who shares the same residence with 10 the individual.

(2) With respect to a corporation, partnership, association,
unincorporated organization or other form of entity, however organized,
including a nonprofit entity, which is:

14 (A) Directly or indirectly controlling, controlled by or under common15 control by a person; or

(B) an officer or director of a person or a person performing similarfunctions.

(h) (i) "Registrant" means a person who is registered by the
 commissioner as a credit services organization.

(i) (j) "Trust account" means an account established by the applicant
 or registrant in a federally insured financial institution used to hold funds
 paid by consumers to a credit services organization for disbursement to
 creditors of consumers that is designated as a trust account or other
 appropriate designation indicating the funds in the account are:

(1) Not funds of the applicant or registrant or its owners, officers oremployees; and

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(2) unavailable to creditors of the applicant or registrant.

28 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 50-1116 and 50-1117 are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the Kansas register.

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
