AN ACT concerning consumer transactions; relating to the Kansas retailers' sales tax act; requiring notice of the cumulative rate to be printed on electronically printed sales receipts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. All retailers who are required to collect sales tax under K.S.A. 79-3604, and amendments thereto, shall print on the receipt issued to the consumer or user, or conspicuously display on an easily readable sign located near the cash register, the cumulative state and local sales tax rate for the taxing jurisdiction in which such retailer is located. This section shall apply only to receipts that are electronically printed by a cash register or other machine or device that electronically prints receipts. For the purposes of this section, the term "retailers" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in K.S.A. 79-3602, and amendments thereto. This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas retailers' sales tax act.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
