Repeal Outdated Highway Patrol Statutes; HB 2674

HB 2674 amends one statute and repeals five statutes related to the Kansas Highway Patrol:

- KSA 74-2105 is amended to delete language about services to the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services and about the Bureau's officers and employees. This agency was severed from the Highway Patrol in 1988;
- KSA 74-2112 is repealed, as the Department of Transportation no longer provides headquarters for the Highway Patrol;
- KSA 74-2116 is repealed, as a specific requirement to pay for expenses monthly is no longer needed;
- KSA 74-2119 is repealed; it transferred equipment and supplies to the Highway Patrol in 1937;
- KSA 74-2125 is repealed; it transferred an old Highway Patrol fund to the State General Fund in the 1980s; and
- KSA 74-2133 is repealed; it allowed the Highway Patrol to sell a building in 1989.
