Permanent Ban on City or County Requirements for Residential Fire Sprinklers

House Sub. for SB 101 permanently restricts cities and counties from adopting or enforcing any ordinance, code, or other policy that requires the installation of a multipurpose residential fire protection sprinkler system in a residential structure. (This replaces a temporary ban that was enacted in 2010.) It prohibits a city or county from requiring the installation of such a sprinkler system as a condition for the consideration or approval of a building permit or plat.
