SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2175

As Recommended by House Committee on Government Efficiency

Brief*

HB 2175 repeals the statutes authorizing the Highway Advisory Commission.

Background

The bill was requested by the Highway Advisory Commission and supported by the Kansas Department of Transportation. The Commission was established in 1975 and the Chairperson of the Commission said that a more comprehensive entity with a multi-modal focus could appropriately address the different aspects of transportation rather the focusing exclusively on highways.

There was no opponent to the bill.

The fiscal note indicated that savings of \$6,525, all from the State Highway Fund, would result in FY 2012 if the Commission were abolished.
