## SESSION OF 2011

### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2267

#### As Recommended by House Committee on Energy and Utilities

## Brief\*

HB 2267 would require the Kansas Corporation Commission to issue a biennial report on electric supply and demand for all electric utilities in Kansas, beginning February 1, 2013. The report would include, but not be limited to, generation capacity needs, system peak capacity needs, and renewable generation needs associated with the 2009 Kansas renewable energy standards. The report would be submitted to the House Energy and Utilities Committee and the Senate Utilities Committee.

The bill was recommended for placement on the Consent Calendar.

# Background

A representative of the Kansas Corporation Commission testified in support of the bill. The Commission has generated this type of report intermittently over the years, including a version created for the Kansas Energy Council Electricity Committee in 2008.

There was no testimony in opposition to the bill.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates costs incurred by the Kansas Corporation Commission resulting from the bill would be negligible.
