### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2569

### As Recommended by House Committee on Judiciary

### **Brief\***

HB 2569 would extend for five years exceptions to the Kansas Open Records Act that are set to expire July 1, 2012.

# Background

KSA 45-229 provides for the expiration of open records exceptions after five years, requiring regular legislative review and reauthorization of each. HB 2569 would renew those provisions set to expire in 2012. No proponents or opponents offered testimony on the bill in the House Committee on Judiciary.

The fiscal note indicates passage of HB 2569 would have no fiscal effect.
