SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2687

As Recommended by House Committee on Government Efficiency

Brief*

HB 2687 would amend two statutes related to reporting requirements of the State Building Advisory Commission (Commission).

KSA 2011 Supp 75-3717b would be amended to no longer require the Commission to report and make recommendations to the Division of the Budget, the Joint Committee on State Building Construction, and the Legislative Research Department on each capital improvement budget estimate submitted by state agencies that included project costs, the scheduling of funding for such costs, and other matters deemed appropriate by the Commission.

KSA 46-1702 would be amended to conform with the changes made in the Commission reporting requirements by removing the requirement that the Joint Committee study the Commission reports.

Background

The bill was introduced at the request of the Governor's Office of the Repealer. The Secretary of Administration testified in favor of the bill before the House Committee on Government Efficiency indicating the reports have not been compiled for years and the information needed to prepare the budget estimates for the Joint Committee is not available. opposing or neutral testimony was presented to the House Committee.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
