SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 21

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Education

Brief*

SB 21 would allow any school district having authority for ancillary school facilities weighting, cost of living weighting, or declining enrollment weighting to spend the motor vehicle-related revenue derived as a result of these weightings. Current law allows a school district to receive this revenue, but not to spend the revenue.

Background

This bill was recommended by the Legislative Education Planning Commission.

Proponents of the bill included Senator John Vratil, and representatives of the Blue Valley, Shawnee Mission, and Olathe school districts.

The Division of the Budget fiscal note stated there would be no fiscal effect.
