1 A RESOLUTION in memory of Representative Rocky Fund.
2 WHEREAS, Representative Rocky Fund, 60, of Hoyt, died April 28,
3 2011. A Kansas legislator, he was elected to the House of Representatives
4 starting in 2006 and was serving his third term; and
5 WHEREAS, Representative Fund was born August 5, 1950, in Sabetha,
6 Kansas, to Marty and Aleck Fund. He attended school in Goff, Kansas and
7 graduated from Wetmore High School. He later completed a bachelor's
8 degree at Wichita State University. He was a specialist in equine foot care,
9 also known as a farrier, in Wichita and northeast Kansas. He worked at
10 Learjet before earning a farrier's license from Oklahoma Farrier's College;

12 WHEREAS, Representative Fund is remembered for his commitment
13 to his constituency from House district number 50, for serving as a
14 member of the agriculture and natural resources committee, federal and
15 state affairs committee, joint committee on special claims against the state,
16 committee on energy and natural resources and as the vice chairperson of
17 the committee on government efficiency and fiscal oversight; and
18 WHEREAS, Representative Fund proudly served in the United States
19 military during the Vietnam era. After graduation, he joined the air force
20 and was stationed at McConnell Air Force Base in Wichita and served in
21 southeast Asia during the Vietnam war; and
22 WHEREAS, Representative Fund leaves a wife, Linda; a daughter,
23 Jesse Davis and her husband Chris; a son, Matt, and his wife Angalee Van
24 Meter and a granddaughter, Layla Fund, and grandson, Cody Fund; and

1 WHEREAS, A lifelong Kansan, representative Fund was very involved
2 in his community and was committed to education and water issues. He
3 was an Optimist, a member of the American Legion and Veterans of
4 Foreign Wars. He was also a teacher and coach at Royal Valley and
5 Jackson Heights for 21 years. He served on the Rural Water District #3
6 Jackson County Water Board for 16 years before becoming its District
7 Manager for 10 years: Now, therefore,

9 That we extend our deepest sympathy to the family and friends of Rocky
10 Fund and thank him for the years of public service he gave to his state and
11 community; and
