65-4a07. Late term abortions; performed in hospital or ambulatory surgical center only; exception. Except in the case of a medical emergency, as defined in this act, and amendments thereto, an abortion performed when the gestational age of the unborn child is 22 weeks or more shall be performed in a hospital or ambulatory surgical center licensed pursuant to this act. All other abortions shall be performed in a hospital, ambulatory surgical center or facility licensed pursuant to this act.
