To Whom It May Concern:

I'm writing this in regard to the CDL testing procedures the state of Kansas has initiated over the past couple years. Additionally, I would like to point out some of the headaches the new testing requirements have caused our business as well as state employees at the DMV.

As custom harvesters, we require our employees to complete their CDL before the season begins in the late spring. For many years, a private instructor from the state would come to our home base and carry out the "driving" part of the CDL exam. This worked smoothly and went very well for us over the years. It essentially allowed a larger group of employees to complete the driving skills test in a short period of time. It also helped keep the larger group out of the nearly booked full DMV offices.

However, over recent years the state of Kansas has changed laws regarding CDL testing. The new laws require everyone obtaining a CDL to go through DMV offices for both the written and driving parts of the exam. This has proved to be a major obstacle for us as a business here in Kansas. We might have 15-20 employees who need to complete their CDL exam before harvest begins. The state DMV offices are NOT equipped with enough personnel to complete this amount of exams in a timely fashion. We have been faced with weeks of delays for our drivers; and as a business that hurts us. We're not the only ones feeling the stress in this situation; already overloaded DMV examiners are faced with even more people to test. With that in mind, I feel like the private instructor was not as rushed and able to complete a more thorough exam.

For the *benefit* of both parties involved, I would like to encourage the state to once again allow private state examiners to come onsite for CDL driving exams.
