I had just turned 19 years old and I was over three months pregnant. Before the abortion they performed a sonogram, but I was not allowed to see the results of the sonogram. There is no doubt that my unborn child had a strong heartbeat at that stage. I firmly believe that, given the chance to see my child on the sonogram screen or to hear the heartbeat, I would have made a life-changing decision to give birth. Unfortunately for my unborn child, I made another life-changing decision that I have lived to regret EVERY DAY of my life. After more than twenty years of suffering, I finally received counseling to deal with the guilt of that abortion. I also volunteered with an organization that helped others who have been through the pain of abortion to find healing for their souls. I am in TOTAL SUPPORT of HB 2324. That heartbeat of my unborn child could have been spared if there had been a law in place like this back in 1980. Thank you for considering my story in your important decision.
