Re: SB 28, Authorizing the division of emergency management within the adjutant general's department to accept certain real property.

Senate Bill No. 28 authorizes the Division of Emergency Management in the Adjutant General's Department to accept from the federal government a transfer of a certain parcel of real property in Saline County. This tract of land is legally described in subsection (b) of the bill and the bill also provides that the Attorney General approve the instrument of conveyance before the described property may be conveyed. Such conveyance authorized by this section shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 75-3043a, which requires three appraisals before the state may accept real property.

The tract of land described in SB 28 is commonly known as Crisis City, a training complex which hosts training exercises for emergency responders.

The effective date of the bill is upon publication in the Kansas Register.
