Re: SB1587 Kansas Pet Animal Act

I have been a licensed animal breeder for a very long time. I have belonged to KPP since it has started. I have been President for six years and have strived to make it better.

I do think some of the things the Ag. Dept. are wanting to do is not going to improve the industry when you are wanting to increase the cap fees. See page 11; line 5-16. I think that 25% to 50% increase in our fees is sufficient. The cap they want will harm the industry as some people will get out because they will not be able to afford such an increase.

We believe the 47-1721(f) needs to be reinstated into the law. I do not agree with the dual licensing fee. One premise only one fee. See page 12, line 14-19.

I think the Governor should appoint the advisory board not the Ag. Dept. See page 12; line 41. That is how it has been done since the program has started.

Delete the words; Federal Government and International Entity. This is the State of Kansas law. Only those licensed by the State of Kansas should hold this position. See page 13, line 2.

Private citizen needs to remain a private citizen with no link to the industry. See page 13, line 9 & 10.
