**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT BRIEF
SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2143**

As Agreed to May 2, 2014

Brief*

Sub. for HB 2143 would reconcile amendments to statutes that have been amended more than once during the 2014 Legislative Session and previous sessions. The bill would combine non-contradictory amendments from enacted legislation to produce one version of the statute.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the *Kansas Register*.

Conference Committee Action

The Conference Committee deleted the contents of Senate Sub. for HB 2143, an appropriations bill, and inserted the contents of HB 2778, the reconciliation bill.

Background

The Revisor of Statutes submits a bill of this type annually to reconcile conflicting statutes.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates this bill would have no fiscal effect.
