**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2193 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2193 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2193 would align the state accessibility laws with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

According to the League of Kansas Municipalities, passage of HB 2193 would increase costs for cities in Kansas. Cities are subject to the ADA requirements, and a number of significant changes were made to the Act in 2008. The League states that the number of cities that would be affected by passage of this bill is unknown; therefore, an exact fiscal effect cannot be determined.
