SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2300 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2300 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2300 would amend existing law to allow the Board of County Commissioners for Reno County, Kansas, to establish term limits for Board members by county resolution. The proposed limit would be two four-year terms. The bill specifies the process to be followed to petition for and vote on the resolution. The resolution would not take effect until it had been approved by a majority of the qualified electors of Reno County at the next general election.

According to the Kansas Association of Counties, passage of HB 2300 would have no fiscal effect on Kansas counties.
