
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2570 by House Committee on Veterans, Military and
Homeland Security

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2570 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2570 would allow any Kansas resident with a disabled veteran license plate to park without charge in any space in a public parking facility that is clearly marked as being reserved for the use of persons with a disability; or persons responsible for the transportation of a person with a disability. Each person would be required to comply with all regulations and restrictions posted by management at the entrance of the public parking facility.

The Department of Revenue indicates that HB 2570 would have no fiscal effect on the expenditures or revenues of the Department.
