
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2597 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2597 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2597 would allow a city with an existing municipal trash service to add recycling services immediately if a public hearing is held to introduce the plan, the city published notice of the hearing 21 days in advance, and no existing recycling collector formally opposes the new city plan.

The League of Kansas Municipalities states that passage of HB 2597 would have little, if any, fiscal effect for Kansas cities.
