
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2599 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2599 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2599 would authorize the Office of the Secretary of State to grant an easement on land along the Kansas River for use by the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City for use as a boat ramp. The deed granting the easement must be approved by the Office of the Attorney General and executed by the Secretary of State.

The Office of the Secretary of State indicates that the costs associated with HB 2599 would be negligible and could be absorbed within existing resources. The Office also indicates that the cost to the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City could be absorbed within existing resources.
