SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 146 by Senate Committee on Agriculture

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 146 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture regulates milk and dairy production in the state. SB 146 would amend current law to allow milk producers to make deliveries directly to consumers. The bill would also remove existing language that limits the advertising of raw milk to a sign on the premises of a dairy farm.

The passage of SB 146 would have no fiscal effect for the Kansas Department of Agriculture.
