SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 158 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 158 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 158 would amend the Kansas Open Records Act to prohibit disclosure of the name and contact information for any person licensed to carry concealed handguns, anyone who has enrolled in or completed a concealed carry course, or anyone who had applied for a concealed carry license.

The Office of the Attorney General states that the passage of SB 158 would have no fiscal effect.
