
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 236 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 236 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 236 would require administrators of adult care homes and medical care facilities to report any resident death to the coroner of the county in which the death occurred, regardless of what caused the death. The bill would also make technical changes to update state agency names and which state agency certain reports are to be filed with to conform to Executive Reorganization Order No. 41.

The passage of SB 236 would have no fiscal effect.
