SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 346 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 346 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 346 would increase the maximum number of barrels of domestic beer that a holder of a microbrewery license is authorized to manufacture and store during a license year from 15,000 to 60,000 barrels.

The Department of Revenue indicates that SB 346 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues, but would increase liquor tax receipts if additional barrels of domestic beer were manufactured and sold. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that it cannot determine what fiscal effect passage of SB 346 may have on Kansas counties.
