SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 356 by Joint Committee on Special Claims Against the State


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 356 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 356 would direct agencies to pay claims against the state from their existing State General Fund appropriations and special revenue funds in FY 2014. The claims in this bill affect the Department of Corrections, Department for Aging and Disability Services, the Legislature, the State Treasurer, the University of Kansas, the Department of Administration, and the Department of Revenue.
