AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to policies against bullying; 1 2 amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 72-8256 and repealing the existing 3 section. 4 5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 72-8256 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 72-8256. (a) As used in this section: 8 (1) "Bullying" means: (A) Any intentional gesture or any intentional 9 written, verbal, electronic or physical act or threat either by any student-or, staff member or parent towards a student or by any student, staff 10 member or parent towards a staff member that is sufficiently severe, 11 12 persistent or pervasive that-it such gesture, act or threat creates an 13 intimidating, threatening or abusive educational environment for a student 14 or staff member that a reasonable person, under the circumstances, knows 15 or should know will have the effect of: 16 (i) Harming a student or staff member, whether physically or 17 mentally; damaging a student's or staff member's property; 18 (ii) 19 (iii) placing a student or staff member in reasonable fear of harm to 20 the student or staff member; or 21 (iv) placing a student or staff member in reasonable fear of damage to 22 the student's or staff member's property; 23 (B) cyberbullying; or 24 (C) any other form of intimidation or harassment prohibited by the board of education of the school district in policies concerning bullying 25 26 adopted pursuant to this section or subsection (e) of K.S.A. 72-8205, and 27 amendments thereto. 28 "Cyberbullying" means bullying by use of any electronic (2)29 communication device through means including, but not limited to, e-mail, instant messaging, text messages, blogs, mobile phones, pagers, online 30 31 games and websites. 32 "Parent" includes a guardian, custodian or other person with (3) 33 authority to act on behalf of the child. (3) (4) "School district" or "district" means any unified school 34 35 district organized and operating under the laws of this state. (3) (4) (5) "School vehicle" means any school bus, school van, other 36

school vehicle and private vehicle used to transport students or staff 1 2 members to and from school or any school-sponsored activity or event.

(5) (6) "Staff member" means any person employed by a school 3 4 district.

5 (b) The board of education of each school district shall adopt a policy 6 to prohibit bullying *either by any student-or*, *staff member* or parent 7 towards a student or by a student, staff member or parent towards a staff 8 *member* on or while utilizing school property, in a school vehicle or at a 9 school-sponsored activity or event.

10 (c) The board of education of each school district shall adopt and 11 implement a plan to address bullying either by any student-or, staff 12 member or parent towards a student or by a student, staff member or parent towards a staff member on school property, in a school vehicle or 13 14 at a school-sponsored activity or event. Such plan shall include provisions 15 for the training and education for staff members and students.

16 (d) The board of education of each school district may adopt 17 additional policies relating to bullying pursuant to subsection (e) of K.S.A. 72-8205, and amendments thereto. 18

19 (e) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit or supersede or 20 in any manner affect or diminish the requirements of compliance by a staff 21 member with the provisions of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 38-2223 or 38-2226, and 22 amendments thereto. 23

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 72-8256 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 24 25 publication in the statute book.
