AN ACT concerning the prescription monitoring program; relating to user fees; amending K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 65-1684 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 65-1684 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-1684. The board shall not impose any charge for the establishment or maintenance of the prescription monitoring program database on a registered wholesale distributor, pharmacist, dispenser or other person authorized to prescribe or dispense scheduled substances and drugs of concern. The board shall not charge any fees for the transmission of data to the database or for the receipt of information from the database, except that the board may charge—a an annual portal fee for use of the prescription monitoring program and other programs that serve pharmacists and non-pharmacists, including, but not limited to, a wholesale distributor, pharmacist, dispenser or other person authorized to prescribe or dispense scheduled substances and drugs of concern and to an individual who requests the individual's own prescription monitoring information in accordance with procedures adopted by the board. Such annual portal fee shall not exceed the cost of operating the program.
