AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school finance litigation.

 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. In any action challenging the adequacy of the state's suitable provision for finance of the educational interests of the state, the state's burden of proof as to adequacy is satisfied by a prima facie showing that the moneys appropriated to the state board of education to be expended in general state aid, supplemental general state aid, special education services aid, school district capital outlay state aid, school district capital improvements state aid and KPERS-employer contributions under the Kansas public employees retirement system to all school districts is at least 50% of all moneys appropriated from the state general fund of the applicable fiscal year.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
