1 2	AN ACT concerning social welfare; relating to the governor's mental health services planning council; amending K.S.A. 39-1606 and K.S.A.
3	2012 Supp. 39-1605 and repealing the existing sections.
4	2012 Supp. 59-1005 and repeating the existing sections.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
6	Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 39-1605 is hereby amended to read as
7	follows: 39-1605. (a) There is hereby established the governor's-mental
8	<i>behavioral</i> health services planning council. The council shall consist of
9	$\frac{25}{33}$ members.
10	(b) So the composition of the council is in compliance with the
11	requirements of public law 102-321 and supplementary federal acts,
12	persons appointed to the council will be in accordance with the following:
13	(1) Nine members shall be state agency representatives who shall
14	include:
15	(A) The commissioner of mental health and developmental
16	disabilities secretary for aging and disability services or the secretary's
17	designee;
18	(B) the secretary-of social and rehabilitation services for children and
19	families shall appoint one member for each of the following areas:
20	Vocational rehabilitation, alcohol and drug abuse services, medical-
21	services and children and family services;
22	(C) the commissioner of juvenile justice, or the commissioner's
23	designee;
24	(D) the commissioner of education;
25	(E) the secretary of corrections; and
26	(F) the secretary of commerce. If a commissioner or secretary is
27	unable to participate, the commissioner or secretary shall appoint a
28	designee as the official member of the council-; and
29	(G) the secretary for aging and disability services shall appoint one
30	member for each of the following areas: Substance use disorder services
31	and medical services.
32	(2) The governor shall appoint the following persons to the council:
33	(A) One member shall be a person licensed to practice medicine and
34	surgery with board certification in psychiatry;
35	(B) two members shall be executive directors of mental health
36	centers; and

1 (C) one member shall be a representative of a behavioral health 2 advocacy group;

3 (D) one member shall be a substance use disorder prevention 4 professional;

5 (E) two members shall be executive directors of substance use 6 disorder treatment centers;

7 (C) 13 (F) 17 members shall be individuals who are not state 8 employees or providers of mental behavioral health services. Of the 13 17 9 members, four members shall be adult consumers with serious and 10 persistent mental illness; three two members shall be immediate family members of adult consumers with serious and persistent mental illnesses; 11 12 four members shall be family members of minor children or youth with severe emotional disturbances; disturbance; one member shall be a child 13 with severe emotional disturbance; two members shall be adults in 14 15 recovery from substance use disorders; one member shall be a family 16 member of an adult with a substance use disorder; one member shall be a 17 mentor to an adult with a substance use disorder: and two members shall be members of the general public. 18

19 (c) The terms of members who are currently serving on the council 20 shall expire on the effective date of this act. At that time, appointees of the 21 governor under subsection (b)(2) shall be appointed to the council by the 22 governor with $\frac{1}{2}$ appointed for a term of two years and the other $\frac{1}{2}$ for a 23 term of four years as specified by the governor July 1, 2013. Thereafter, 24 each member appointed to the council by the governor shall be appointed 25 for a term of four years.

(d) Each member of the council shall serve until a successor is
appointed and qualified. In the case of a vacancy on the council, a
successor of like qualifications shall be appointed or designated to fill the
unexpired term in accordance with subsections (b)(1) and (2) subsection
(b).

(e) The governor shall designate the chairperson of the council. Themembers of the council shall elect a vice-chairperson.

(f) Members of the governor's mental behavioral health services
planning council attending meetings of the council, or attending a
subcommittee meeting thereof authorized by the council, shall be paid
amounts provided in subsection (e) of K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments
thereto.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 39-1606 is hereby amended to read as follows: 39-1606. (a) The governor's-mental *behavioral* health services planning council shall hold regular quarterly meetings and such other meetings as the chairperson of such council deems advisable, and in addition shall meet at such other times upon the call of the secretary.

43 (b) It is the duty of the governor's-mental *behavioral* health services

1 planning council to:

2 (1) Confer, advise and consult with the secretary with respect to the 3 policies governing the management and operation of all state psychiatric 4 hospitals and facilities and community based<u>mental</u> behavioral health 5 services;

6 (2) serve as an advocate for targeted population members and other 7 individuals with mental illness, *behavioral health* or emotional problems;

8 (3) monitor, review and evaluate, not less than once each year, the 9 allocation and adequacy of mental *behavioral* health services within the 10 state;

(4) perform such other planning, reviewing and evaluating of mental
 behavioral health services in this state, as may be requested by the
 secretary or as may be prescribed by law; and

(5) consult with and advise the governor, from time to time, with
 reference to the management, conduct and operation of state psychiatric
 hospitals and mental *behavioral* health programs.

17 (c) A member or members of the governor's mental behavioral health 18 services planning council, at least once each year, shall visit each state 19 psychiatric hospital and may visit other providers of community based 20 mental behavioral health services for the purpose of inspecting the state 21 psychiatric hospital, mental health center or the facility of other such 22 providers of community based-mental behavioral health services. Such 23 visits shall be made at such times and in such manner as the council 24 determines at a regular meeting.

(d) The governor's—mental *behavioral* health services planning
 council shall make annual reports to the governor and the members of the
 legislature and may make such recommendations as it deems advisable for
 appropriate legislation.
