AN ACT concerning economic development; relating to rural opportunity 1 zones; amending K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 74-50,222 and repealing the 2 3 existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 74-50,222 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 74-50,222.
