Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 8-2112 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2112. (a) Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found parked, standing or stopped in violation of this act or any ordinance, the officer finding such vehicle shall take its registration number and may take any other information displayed on the vehicle which may identify its user, and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a traffic citation.

- (b) No more than one traffic citation shall be issued during a four-hour period to any motor vehicle found parked, standing or stopped in the same location.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-2112 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
