AN ACT concerning public assistance programs; relating to the state-issued photo ID.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2015, the secretary for children and families shall require any recipient of public assistance provided under the programs of the Kansas department for children and families or any parent or legal guardian of such recipient to show a state-issued photo identification card to any person who renders services to such recipient or who transacts business dealing with the benefits of such recipient.

- (b) Any recipient of public assistance or any parent or legal guardian of such recipient shall obtain a state-issued photo identification card, which can be either a driver's license or nondriver's identification card, in order to show upon request during any business transaction using the benefits from the public assistance programs or when receiving training or attending a workshop of any public assistance program or service. Any person who renders services to recipients of public assistance and who transacts business dealing with the benefits of such recipients shall check the identification of such recipients or any parent or legal guardian of such recipients or parent or legal guardian of such recipients or parent or legal guardian of such recipients.
- (c) The secretary for children and families shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to administer and implement the provisions of this section.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
