## **HOUSE BILL No. 2751**

AN ACT concerning insurance; relating to property and casualty insurance; prohibiting the cancellation or non-renewal of policies due to claims from catastrophe, natural disasters, acts of nature or weather-related causes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) An insurer shall not cancel or non-renew any property and casualty insurance policy issued or renewed in this state on or after July 1, 2014, based solely on a claim arising from catastrophe, natural disaster, acts of nature or weather-related causes.

(b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit an insurer from canceling or non-renewing a property and casualty insurance policy in the event of a claim arising from catastrophe, natural disaster, acts of nature or weather-related causes if there are additional substantial reasons for such action such as concealment, misrepresentation or fraud by the insured relating to such property and casualty policy, whether before or after the claim.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
