Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. K.S.A. 35-205 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-205. (a) The fourth Saturday of September of the present year of our Lord 1945, and the fourth Saturday of September of each year thereafter is hereby designated as "American Indian Day."
- (b) The first Wednesday of February of 2014, and the first Wednesday of February of each year thereafter is hereby designated as "Native American Legislative Day at the Capitol."
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 35-205 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
