1 AN ACT concerning the highway patrol training center fund; amending  
2 K.S.A. 74-2134 and repealing the existing section.

3  
4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 74-2134 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-  
6 2134. ~~(a)~~ There is hereby created in the state treasury the highway patrol  
7 training center fund. All moneys credited to such fund under the  
8 provisions of this act or any other law shall be expended only for the  
9 purpose and in the manner prescribed by law. *All expenditures from the*  
10 *highway patrol training center fund shall be made in accordance with*  
11 *appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports*  
12 *issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the superintendent of the*  
13 *highway patrol or the designee of the superintendent. All moneys received*  
14 *for the highway patrol training center fund shall be deposited in the state*  
15 *treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and*  
16 *amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the highway patrol training*  
17 *center fund.*

18 ~~(b) Commencing on June 30, 1992, and on each June 30 thereafter,~~  
19 ~~the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from the highway patrol~~  
20 ~~training center fund to the state general fund \$500,000.~~

21 ~~(c) All amounts transferred from the highway patrol training center~~  
22 ~~fund to the state general fund under subsection (b) are to reimburse the~~  
23 ~~state general fund for the cost of financing the training of the personnel of~~  
24 ~~the Kansas highway patrol which is financed from the state general fund~~  
25 ~~and for accounting, auditing, budgeting, legal, payroll, personnel and~~  
26 ~~purchasing services and any other governmental services which are~~  
27 ~~performed on behalf of the state agency involved by other state agencies~~  
28 ~~which receive appropriations from the state general fund to provide such~~  
29 ~~services. Such reimbursements are in addition to those authorized by~~  
30 ~~K.S.A. 75-3170a, and amendments thereto.~~

31 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-2134 is hereby repealed.

32 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
33 publication in the statute book.
