## SENATE BILL No. 121

By Committee on Public Health and Welfare

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AN ACT concerning state institutions; regarding licensure and renewal of licenses; amending K.S.A. 65-429 and repealing the existing section.

Section 1. K.S.A. 65-429 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 429. Upon receipt of an application for license, the licensing agency shall 7 issue with the approval of the state fire marshal a license provided the 8 applicant and the physical facilities of the medical care facility meet the 9 requirements established under this act. A license, unless suspended or 10 revoked, shall be renewable annually without charge upon the filing by the 11 licensee, and approval by the licensing agency, of an annual report upon 12 such uniform dates and containing such information in such form as the 13 licensing agency prescribes by rules and regulations. A medical care 14 facility which has been licensed by the licensing agency and which has 15 received certification for participation in federal reimbursement programs 16 and which has been accredited by the joint commission on accreditation of 17 health care organizations or the American osteopathic association may be 18 granted a license renewal based on such certification and accreditation. 19 The cost of administration of the medical care facilities licensure and risk 20 management program provisions of this act pursuant to K.S.A. 65-433 and 21 65-4921et seg., and amendments thereto, shall be funded by an annual 22 assessment from the health care stabilization fund, which assessment shall 23 not exceed \$200,000 in any one fiscal year. The licensing agency shall 24 make an annual report to the health care stabilization fund regarding the 25 use of these funds. Each license shall be issued only for the premises and 26 persons or governmental units named in the application and shall not be 27 transferable or assignable except with the written approval of the licensing 28 agency. Except for Osawatamie state hospital and rainbow mental health 29 facility, a separate license is not required for two separate establishments 30 which unless those establishments are located in the same or contiguous 31 counties, which provide the services required by K.S.A. 65-431, and 32 amendments thereto, and which are organized under a single owner or 33 governing board with a single designated administrator and medical staff. 34 Licenses shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the licensed premises.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-429 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

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1 publication in the statute book.
