1 AN ACT concerning sexually violent predators; relating to reimbursement  
2 for costs incurred by counties.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) Whenever a person civilly committed pursuant to  
6 K.S.A. 59-29a01 et seq., and amendments thereto, is in the custody of a  
7 county law enforcement agency, the costs incurred for the care and  
8 custody of such person by the county with custody of such person,  
9 including, but not limited to, costs of medical care and treatment, housing,  
10 food and transportation, shall be paid by such county. Such county shall be  
11 reimbursed for all such costs by the secretary for aging and disability  
12 services from the Larned state hospital – sexual predator treatment  
13 program account of the state general fund. If there are no moneys available  
14 in such fund to pay any such reimbursements, the county may file a claim  
15 against the state pursuant to article 9 of chapter 46 of the Kansas Statutes  
16 Annotated, and amendments thereto. The secretary for aging and disability  
17 services shall develop and implement a procedure to provide such  
18 reimbursements on or before July 1, 2014.

19 (b) All expenditures pursuant to this section from the Larned state  
20 hospital – sexual predator treatment program account of the state general  
21 fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of  
22 the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved  
23 by the secretary for aging and disability services or the secretary's  
24 designee.

25 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
26 publication in the Kansas register.
