1 AN ACT concerning agriculture; relating to the plant pest and agriculture 2 commodity certification act; live plant dealer's licenses; amending 3 K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 2-2120 and repealing the existing section. 4 5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 2-2120 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 2-2120. (a) Every live plant dealer, before selling or offering for 8 sale or delivering any live plants in this state, shall procure from the 9 secretary a live plant dealer's license for each location from which such live plant dealer engages in business as a live plant dealer. 10 (b) The secretary shall provide for two live plant dealer's license 11 12 types: 13 (1) A live plant dealer whose gross receipts for activities defined 14 under subsection (f) of K.S.A. 2-2113, and amendments thereto, is \$10,000 15 or more in a calendar year or who imports or exports plants into or out of 16 the state of Kansas, shall be issued a standard live plant dealer's license. 17 The fee for such license shall not exceed \$80; and 18 (2) a live plant dealer whose gross receipts for activities defined 19 under subsection (f) of K.S.A. 2-2113, and amendments thereto, is less 20 than \$10,000 in a calendar year and who does not import or export plants 21 into or out of the state of Kansas, shall be issued a limited live plant 22 dealer's license. The fee for such license shall not exceed \$40. 23 Application for such a live plant dealer's license shall be made (b) (c) 24 on a form furnished by the secretary. The fee for each application shall be 25 fixed by rules and regulations adopted by the secretary, except that such 26 fee shall not exceed \$80, excluding the plant pest emergency fee, authorized pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 2-2129, and amendments 27 28 thereto. 29 (c) A live plant dealer shall not be required to obtain a license if such 30 live plant dealer does not import or export plants into or from the state and 31 the annual gross receipts of such live plant dealer's business is less than 32 \$10,000. 33 Such All live plant dealer's license licenses shall expire on (d) 34 January 31, following date of issue. All live plant dealer's licenses shall be 35 renewed by February 1 of each calendar year. The secretary may establish and charge a late fee for any license that is not renewed by March 1 of any 36

calendar year. Such late fee shall not exceed \$150. 1

(e) A live plant dealer may only engage in the live plant business with 2 live plants which are: 3

(1) In compliance with all quarantines and regulated nonquarantine 4 pest freedom standards established by the secretary; or 5

accompanied by a valid certificate of inspection of a federal 6 (2)inspector or inspector of another state stating that such live plants comply 7 with all applicable quarantines and regulated nonquarantine pest freedom 8 9 standards.

(f) A live plant dealer shall not be required to obtain a separate 10 license for sales at a farmer's market registered with the secretary, as 11 provided by law, and at which sales are made no more than one time per 12 week. Live plant dealers shall disclose to the secretary the farmer's 13 markets at which they intend to sell live plants. 14 15

K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 2-2120 is hereby repealed. Sec. 2.
