State Use Law; SB 63

SB 63 allows municipalities, as defined by KSA 2013 Supp. 75-6102 to include counties, cities, townships, and other taxing subdivisions of the state, to purchase products and services on the list certified by the Director of Purchases for qualified vendors. The bill grants the State Use Law Committee the power to elect its chairperson and removes the Governor's power to designate one of the private-sector business members as chairperson. The bill also extends the State Use Law Committee's sunset date by five years, from July 1, 2014, to July 1, 2019.
